

AIR Time

What is AIR Time?

- Academic intervention during the school day to help your child with his/her area(s) of need

Procedures

- Students view AIR Time sessions electronically
 - <https://sites.google.com/pasadenaisd.org/rmsstudent>
- On Tuesday, teachers notify students required to attend intervention and stamp Priority Session in student planners.
 - Monday – SS Priority Day
 - Tuesday – Math Priority Day
 - Thursday – Reading Priority Day
 - Friday – Science Priority Day
- Students select remaining AIR Time sessions on Wednesday. They write selections in their planners and submit electronically.
- When the AIR Time bell rings:
 - If chosen for a Priority Session, students refer to planner and report to Priority Session.
 - If not chosen for a Priority Session, students refer to planner and report to first choice.
 - If session is full, students refer to planner and report to second choice.
 - Students must report to a session by tardy bell.

Consequences

- Consequences will be assigned if a student:
 - Does not attend a session (truancy) – 5 days lunch detention
 - Does not attend a required Priority Session – 1 day lunch detention
 - Attends a session not applicable to student (i.e. band student attends choir AIR Time session) – classroom removal
 - Does not have planner – student retrieves temporary AIR Time pass from front office before 1st period begins (3 occurrences = 1 day lunch detention)
 - Loses planner - \$1.00 replacement fee
